BOATERS STAYING OVERNIGHT BETWEEN CONANT BOAT RAMP AND LUFKIN BOTTOM MUST COMPLETE A SELF-ISSUE PERMIT.

Please complete the form provided below, deposit the original, and retain a copy in your possession during the overnight stay.

The permit is cost free, and it does not limit numbers of boaters. The purpose is to collect visitor use data, protect bald eagle nesting areas, and sustain recreation opportunities.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- ▶ Camp only in DESIGNATED CAMP AREAS. Maps are provided below, and areas are signed on the river. You may select a campsite anywhere within a Camp Area, but we encourage you to use existing sites.
- ▶ Use of a portable toilet is required when camping overnight. A dump station is located downriver at Byington Boat Access.
- ▶ Camping in Bald Eagle Habitat Areas is prohibited.
