

We want you to go to Exercise 1 now, and what we have are some examples of some resources that could be impacted by any given project.

What we want you to do is go through these resources, pick those that you feel comfortable working with, and identify potential indicators that could be used to measure impacts to these resources from any particular project. It's not really critical what that project is, but just so you get the feel for how would I measure impacts to, say, transportation or wetlands grazing, et cetera, from any given project. List down those indicators. Then what we're going to do is you're going to come back and we're going to provide some examples of indicators for you to compare to so you can kind of get an idea for what you're trying to do with this exercise.

So go ahead and take some time to do this and then you can go to one of our review sections and see the example that we've given.
