

Hello, and welcome to the E-planning basics module Creating a NEPA Project. My name is Joseph Coleman, E-planning specialist with the Bureau of Land Management National Operations Center, and I'll be your instructor. Today we will discuss briefly the steps required to successfully create and modify NEPA projects inside of E-planning. Specifically, our objective will be to create a new NEPA project, modify or edit the background information for this project, and to provide team members access to the project and find their user roles.
