

Creating a Project Website (1610-40): Introduction

Welcome to ePlanning Basics, Publishing a Project Website. This lesson will demonstrate how to successfully publish your project to the NEPA or Land Use Plan registers.

It is assumed at this point that the project that you have been working on has been created, written, reviewed, and is ready to be published.

My name is Udom Hong and I am your ePlanning facilitator. The course objectives for this lesson are to access and log in to the Back Office Application, you will navigate around the Back Office, and we will create a project website. Specifically, we will be using a text editor to add additional content to your website, as well as adding a PDF and interactive document. Once you have all of that set up, we will create a comment period.

Keep in mind that if your project doesn't require a comment period, then you will be creating a Project *Summary* Website as opposed to a Project Website. More information on creating a project summary website will be covered in another course.
