Thanks for joining me for this fairly brief introduction to the topics of tunnel sites and mill sites. You've now been exposed to the various aspects of mill sites. You may encounter situations where exploration or development is proposed to take place following the location of a tunnel site, or that a company may wish to occupy mill site locations for the purpose of processing locatable minerals. Using the applicable laws and the site location regulations in Title 43 of the Code of Federal Regulations, you should be able to have an impression of such exploration or development on a tunnel site, or the use or occupancy of a mill site appears to be valid or not valid. The documentation of such should be done in consultation with professionals who are well versed in the Title 43 CFR Parts 3715, also known as the Use and Occupancy Regulations, and 3809 or Surface Management Regulations. If you feel the validity of a site should be evaluated further, the services of a certified mineral examiner must be employed. I hope this course has been informative.
