Documents Included in Airport Patent Packages

Airport patents for approval by the Department of Justice (DOJ) must include the following documents in the package:

1. <u>Application</u>. A copy of the applicant's application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requesting that lands or interests in lands under the jurisdiction of the Department of the Interior be conveyed to the applicant under Section 516 of the Airport and Airway Improvement Act of September 3, 1982 (49 D.S.C. 47125).

2. <u>Evidence Document.</u> A copy of the document evidencing the legal capability of the proposed grantee to acquire title to, or interest in, land for airport purposes.

3. <u>FAA Letter</u>. A copy of the FAA letter to the BLM approving the application, and setting forth a list of covenants and/or conditions for to be included in the patent.

4. <u>BLM Letter</u>. A copy of the BLM determination letter to the FAA:

(a) Stating that the transfer of the land is not inconsistent with the needs of the Department of the Interior, or any agency thereof. 43 CFR 2641.2(a).

(b) Stating any convenants terms, conditions and reservations that should be included in the conveyance, if made. 43 CFR 2641.2(a).

(c) Stating that the lands are not (1) within any National Park, National Monument, National Recreation Area, or similar area under the administration of the National Park Service; (2) within any unit of the National Wildlife Refuge System or similar area under the jurisdiction of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service; (3) within any area designated part of the National Wilderness Preservation System or any area designated as a wilderness study area; or (4) within any National Forest or Indian Reservations. 43 CFR 2641.2(b).

(d) If all or a portion of the lands are within any of the above described areas, the letter should: (1) identify the area the lands are located within; (2) describe the lands (if only a portion of the lands are within any of the areas); and (3) cite the specific law. Include a copy of the law in the package.

Airport patents for approval by the Department of Justice (DOJ) must include the following documents in the package:

5. <u>Section l02(2)(c) of the National Environmental Policy Act.</u> A copy of BLM's determination stating that the proposed action will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment, pursuant to Section 102(2)(c) of the National Environmental Policy Act.

6. <u>Plats and Maps.</u> As of September 11, 2001, plats and maps of the area to be patented must be included in the package.

7. <u>Federal Register Notice(s).</u> i.e., Notice of Realty Action (NORA)

8. Patents.

(a) Two original patents (one patent for the applicant, and one patent for the BLM records).

(b) Each patent should include the patent number.

(c) Each patent should be signed and date by the State Director (or Acting State Director).
