A review of products purchased by the State Office was conducted by the Compliance Assessment – Safety, Health, Environment (CASHE) Team during the August 2007 audit. This review demonstrated that environmentally-preferable products are not being consistently purchased. The purchases include items that are required to contain recycled products such as paper and remanufactured printer cartridges. In addition, the State Office is not consistently purchasing energy efficient Energy Star products such as copiers, printers, and refrigerators.

Individuals with purchase card authority are reminded of the following:

### Recycled-Content Products

The following table is a list of common office products found by the CASHE Team at the State Office for which environmentally preferable versions that meet the Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines (CPG) minimum recycled content are readily available and must be purchased.



**Purpose:** This Instruction Memorandum transmits the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Green Purchasing Plan. The Green Purchasing Plan is required by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and Executive Order (EO) 13423.

**Policy/Action:** The BLM's personnel will adhere to the requirements of the Green Purchasing Plan (Attachment 1) in order to maximize the use of environmentally friendly products and materials in all aspects of the BLM's acquisition processes.

Timeframe: Effective upon issuance.

## Hazard warning on home cleaners Study says many use chemicals linked to fertility problems

Dozens of common household cleaning products contain hidden toxic chemicals linked to fertility disorders in lab animals, according to data gathered by a women's research group.

A type of glycol ether is frequently found in popular cleaning products such as Windex Aerosol, Formula 409, Lemon Fresh Pine-Sol and Simple Green All Purpose Cleaner, says the report released today by Women's Voices for the Earth, a Montana-based nonprofit working to eliminate or reduce toxic chemicals in the home.

The chemical, called ethylene glycol butyl ether or EGBE, is on California's list of toxic air contaminants. Some animal studies indicate that it produces reproductive problems, such as testicular damage, reduced fertility, death of embryos and birth defects. People exposed to high levels of EGBE for several hours have reported nose and eye irritation, headaches, vomiting and a metallic taste in their mouths, studies show.

It's difficult for consumers to know whether their favorite cleaner contains the chemical because manufacturers aren't required to list it on the label. Neither the state per the federal government regulates.

# How do you get "green" Janitorial Services?

- Check your building lease?
- If the lease was written after July 2000 it should require "green" janitorial services
- New BLM leases written after July 2009 will have "green" janitorial services and lighting maintenance

## **Green Janitorial Services**

#### 2.40. JANITORIAL SERVICES (JUL 2000)

- (a) The Lessor shall provide janitorial services and replacement of supplies for the leased space, public areas, entrances, and all other common areas in accordance with the Janitorial Requirements/Performance Specification, shown at Table 1.
- (b) <u>Selection of Cleaning Products</u>. The Lessor shall make careful selection of janitorial cleaning products and equipment to
  - (1) Use products that are packaged ecologically,
  - (2) Use products and equipment considered environmentally beneficial and/or recycled products that are phosphate free, non-corrosive, non-flammable and biodegradable and
  - (3) Minimize the use of harsh chemicals and the release of irritating fumes. Examples of acceptable products may be found at <a href="http://pub.fss.gsa.gov/environ/clean-prod-catalog.html">http://pub.fss.gsa.gov/environ/clean-prod-catalog.html</a>.
- (c) <u>Selection of Paper Products</u>. The Lessor shall select paper and paper products (i.e., bathroom tissue and paper towels) with recycled content conforming to the EPA's Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines.

# Green Janitorial & Lighting Maintenance [BLM GPP Section 9.2.3]

- Specification is to be used by all organizational units in leased or owned space when a new contract is awarded or when an option is picked up, whichever occurs first.
- BLM offices are to provide the specification to the GSA if they or their State Office is working directly with GSA on a new or renewed lease.
- Collocated or Service First BLM offices are to work with the agency that is responsible for the lease to facilitate incorporation of the green janitorial services and lighting maintenance requirements into the leasing contract.

#### Appendix 4

### Environmentally Preferable Janitorial Services and Lighting Maintenance Specification



Green or environmentally preferable janitorial services must be purchased to the maximum extent practicable. These requirements have already been incorporated into the BLM's standard space leasing contract.

The requirements in this appendix are to be used by all organizational units in leased or owned space when a new contract is awarded or when an option is picked up whichever occurs first.

A justification must be provided when green janitorial services provisions are not used.

Please note: The janitorial service clauses in the typical GSA leasing contract are similar, but they refer to a web site for green cleaning products that does not work and they do not require use for recycled content trash bags. In addition, the GSA leasing contract does not address recycling of fluorescent lamps and other mercury containing bulbs and their proper storage. The specification provided in this Appendix has hyperlinks to web sites that identify sources for green cleaning products, paper products, and trash can liners that must be used and provided by the janitorial service contractor.

#### JANITORIAL SERVICES AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE (FEBRUARY 2009)

- (a) The Lessor/Janitorial Service Contractor shall provide janitorial services and replacement of supplies for the leased space, public areas, entrances, and all other common areas in accordance with the Janitorial Requirements/Performance Specification, shown as Table 1 [Note: Table 1 is site specific and must be prepared by the local office.]
- (b) <u>Selection of Cleaning Products</u>: The janitorial contractor shall make careful selection of janitorial cleaning products and equipment to comply with the following:
- Purchase and use green cleaning products and hand soaps that have the following environmentally responsible features:
  - Non-toxic
  - Contain no phosphates
  - Non-corrosive
  - Contain no ozone depleting compounds
  - Contain no known carcinogens
  - Contain no chlorine bleach




