Subject: Petition/Application for Proposed Withdrawal, Trinity Wild and Scenic River,
California

We request your approval to file a petition/application to withdraw approximately 3,123 acres of public lands from location and entry under the United States mining laws, but not from leasing under the mineral or geothermal leasing laws or disposal under the Materials Act of 1947, on behalf of the Bureau of Land Management. The proposed withdrawal would protect the cultural, recreational, and biological resources within the recreational segment of the Trinity Wild and Scenic River.

Your approval would temporarily segregate the lands for up to 2 years while various studies and analyses are prepared to support a final decision on the withdrawal application. Attached is the information required for submission of a petition/application. We recommend your approval.
