Subject: Extension of Naval Air Station (NAS) Fallon FRTC withdrawal

Dear Ms. Knutson,

In June 2016, the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) received a briefing from the Naval Air Station (NAS) Fallon regarding the extension of the current withdrawal and the proposal to withdraw an additional 680,000 acres of public land. The Shoal Site is withdrawn to the DOE under Public Land Order 2771, as amended through Public Land Order 2834. Under the Shoal withdrawal, DOE is responsible for the sub-surface estate; however, the Department of the Navy is responsible for the surface estate under Public Law 106-65. The DOE consents to the Navy's request to extend the current withdrawal an additional 25 years. The Shoal Site will remain under joint use and control of the Navy and DOE.
