

Legacy Rehost 2000

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has the responsibility for maintaining and mineral records for the United States—what today amounts to more than 1 billion acres of records. The Legacy Rehost 2000 System called LR2000 was established by the BLM in March 1999. The systems which make up LR2000 include: Case Recordation, Status, Legal Land Description, Mining Claim Recordation, Cadastral Survey Index, Bond & Surety, and Bond Master Name. LR2000 contains both a transaction component and a reporting component.






**Step Five – Enter the Test training site for NV**
