Subject: Collection of Financial Guarantee (N-72779)

On June 14, 2006, a decision, required that a financial guarantee of \$74,600.00 be posted to cover reclamation for Notice, N-72779. When the required amount was not posted, a noncompliance order was issued, on August 25, 2006, requiring within 30 days of receiving that decision, commencement of the reclamation required by your Notice, N-72779 or file a new Notice or Plans of Operation for the project area.

On September 28, 2006, the Tonopah Field Office received a letter from Widow, of Mr. Vern Cook, Katina Cook, requesting a six month extension of time to pay the reclamation fees. On October 23, 2006, a decision, for a request for state director review was accepted. On November 13, 2006, a decision on the State Director Review was issued leading to Tonopah Field Office issuing a Suspension Order Decision on November 24, 2006, this suspended all mining and milling operations until the financial guarantee of \$74,600.00 was provided. The Suspension also required for the cease of operations until the financial guarantee was provided and trash and equipment removal, and reclamation earthwork completed within the fenced storage area by May 20th 2007. This was not completed and on July 19, 2007, a Notification of Intent to Revoke Plant of Operations was sent. Followed by a Decision of Plan Revoked, Financial Guarantee Fortfeited on November 14, 2007. A request was made for a State Director Review on January 4, 2008; that review was declined January 23, 2008.

Given the history of this operation, it is unlikely that they will fulfill their obligation for reclamation for surface disturbed areas. In accordance with 43 CFR subpart 3809.597, we are requesting the BLM Nevada State Office immediately collect the forfeited amount of \$14,900.00 for N-72779, as provided by applicable laws for the collection of defaulted financial guarantees.

The Time Deposit was accepted from Vernon and Katina Cook, remitter for Wolff Milling & Mining, as the financial security for a reclamation bond. The bond provides surface reclamation coverage for operations conducted by the principal on NVN072779, the Cook Plan. The current estimated total cost of achieving the reclamation plan requirements for NVN072779 exceeds the bond amount of \$14,900.

The bond appoints the Secretary of the Interior, or the duly authorized delegate, to act as attorney-in-fact for the purpose of negotiating the financial security. As of November 14, 2007, Vernon and Katina Cook have forfeited the security, in the amount of \$14,900, because of defaulting on the bond.
