

We're going to go onto the next exercise, and what we have is we've got a scenario with the Bicknell's Thrush and a project that could affect Bicknell's Thrush, which is an endangered species, and what we would like you to do is go through this scenario, use the cause-and-effect analysis that you worked on for the scenario for the previous module as a planning device, and write an impacts analysis, including all those elements that we talked about before, which are the qualitative description impacts, the use of the resource indicator to indicate the level of impacts, the comparison to the affected environment to get context and severity, and last of all, the comparison back to, say, a no-action alternative, and go through that process and write a simple impacts analysis based on that with this scenario, and then we'll come back and we'll show you an example that we did and we'll also do a debrief on certain elements of that example so you can see how yours compares with that.
