



If Visitor Use numbers are not entered in an area designation, (i.e. WSA), then you will not be able to run a report to display use numbers for the area.


Visitor Use added at the site,




The segment formula takes the estimated use for a given area segment and allocates that use to one or more sites identified in that segment. This allows you to track use for the segment and at each site within the segment area.



The RMIS program takes the use added to each segment and sums them for a total amount of use for the entire area, in our example, the WSA.

This allows you to make use estimates in each segment area, a total for the entire designated area, and use at each site within the area.

This is the same concept that is used for rivers, roads, and trails in the RMIS program.

- Different access points.


Remember – You may only need one segment for an area.


