The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) requests your approval to file a petition/application to extend the duration of the withdrawal created by Public Land Order (PLO) No. 7060 for an additional 20-year period. PLO No. 7060 withdrew 464.93 acres of public land from settlement, sale, location, or entry under the general land laws, including the United States mining laws, to protect capital improvements and resource values at the Sacramento Pass Recreation Area.
