



Map Description

Shooting Star Ranch, LLC and the Forest Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture, are considering an exchange of lands of equal value. The lands considered for exchange are located within the Gardiner Ranger District of the Custer Gallatin National Forest, in Park County, Montana. The Federal lands consist of approximately 590 acres. The non-Federal lands consist of approximately 583 acres. This proposed land exchange would improve long-term management effectiveness, conserve critical wildlife and fisheries habitat, protect streams, ponds and riparian areas, and improve public access for recreation. A decision to complete the exchange will be based on overall public interest.
